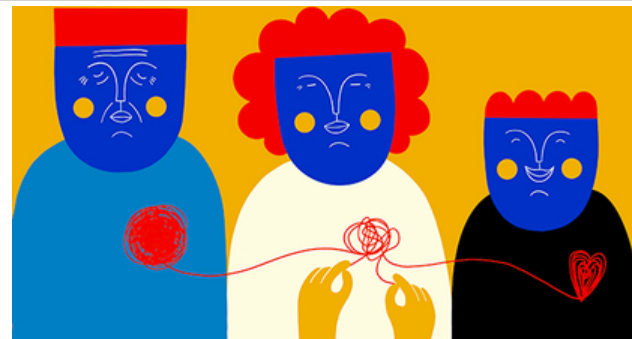
The Forum presented a poster at the National Academy of Neuropsychology Conference in October, 2023 about our recent initiatives!
